Probability:

First, they can be used when we want to say how sure we are that something happened / is happening / will happen. We often call these 'modals of deduction' or 'speculation' or 'certainty' or 'probability'.

Ability We use 'can' and 'could' to talk about a skill or ability.

For example: She can speak six languages. My grandfather could play golf very well. I can't drive.
