Prices and facilities

READING EXERCISE



Calculate the price for the following customers, using the price grid in the brochure. Don't forget to include any necessary supplements and any savers which apply.

- 1) Two adults staying for seven nights and departing on 29 September. They want bed and breakfast.
- 2) One adult staying in a single room for fourteen nights with bed and breakfast, departing 2 October
- 3) Two adults with one child staying for seven nights, departing 2 November. They want a pool view and half-board.
- 4) Two adults and two children, staying for seven nights, half board, departing 22 December.
- 5) Two adults staying for fourteen nights with bed and breakfast, departing 25 November.
- 6) Two adults staying for ten nights with bed and breakfast, departing 25 November.

READING, LANGUAGE FOCUS, PRONUNCIATION FOCUS

Students calculate and quote prices.

From Language focus on pag. 108 students do exercises n° 1 (a and b) and n° 2 then they practice looking back at the calculations they made in exercise n° 6 on page 107.

Pronunciation focus

Students note the difference in pronunciation between *fourteen* and *forty* -/i:/versus /i/, plus main stress difference. Students IN TURN practice and read numbers
