

Gerunds and Infinitives

Gerund (verb + -ing)
Gerund is used :

- After prepositions and phrasal verbs
- As the subject of a sentence.
- After some verbs, e.g. *hate, spend, don't mind*Common verbs which take the gerund include: admit, avoid, deny,
 dislike, enjoy, feel like, finish, hate, keep, like, love, mind, miss, practice.

The negative gerund is not+verb+ing

The infinitive with to is used:

- After adjectives
- To express a reason or purpose
- After some verbs e.g. want, need, learn

The infinitive without to is used:

- After modal and auxiliary verbs
- After make and let
